**The Controller of Examinations presented details about Uniform Evaluation Method of Students based on Relative Grading as per the directions received from Anna University Chennai.**

- ✓ As per the communications received from the Registrar Anna University Chennai Letter No.5883/AU/CAC/Rel. Grading/2022 dated 26.09.2022 the following excerpts from the letter was discussed
- Academic Council of Anna University had decided to introduce a uniform evaluation method for all the UG/PG students of University Departments ,Non –Autonomous colleges and Autonomous Colleges affiliated to Anna University ,for all candidates admitted during the Academic year 2021-2022 onwards from the Dec.2021/Jan.2022 end semester examinations.
- This uniform evaluation method consists of the norms to be followed for the award of marks for internal and end semester examinations of all types of courses, passing requirements ,relative grading and award of letter grades and classification of degree of degree.

- It was resolved that the Uniform Evaluation Method of students based on Relative Grading as approved by the 28th Academic Council Meeting dated 26.09.2022 will be implemented from the Nov. /Dec. 2022 end semester examinations for the 2021-2022 admitted UG/PG students as mentioned in the above communication.
- The award of grade for Project work/internship and Laboratory courses will be done through fixed grading procedure as given below as approved by the 28th Academic Council Meeting dated 26.09.2022.

**Award of UG (Hons) with specialization, UG with Minor and UG(Hons) as per the Anna University, Chennai communication.**

- The communication received from the Registrar i/c, Anna University Chennai with regard to the above agenda item is Letter No. 5749/AU/CAC/Honors/2022 dated 16.11.2022 was discussed.



- Based on the guidelines provided by AICTE, the 28th Academic Council of Anna University has approved the implementation of the following :
  - B.E/B.Tech. (Honors) in the same discipline
  - B.E/B.Tech. Minor in other specialization and
  - B.E/B.Tech. (Honors)
- This shall be implemented for UG candidates from the academic year 2021-2022 onwards.
- B.E. / B.Tech. (Hons) Specialization: Candidate to earn additionally a minimum of 20 credits from a vertical of the same programme
- B.E. / B.Tech. (Hons): Candidates to earn additionally a minimum of 20 credits from more than one vertical of the same programme.
- The candidates who registers for the above classifications should have a Minimum CGPA of 7.50 and should have passed all the courses in the first attempt.
- B.E. / B.Tech (Minor): Candidate to earn additionally a minimum of 20 credits in any one of the verticals of other B.E./ B.Tech programmes.
- The candidates who registers for the above classification should have a Minimum CGPA of 7.50
- 6 credits out of these 20 credits can be completed through online mode (SWAYAM platform)
- B.E/B.Tech (Hons) specialization in the same discipline, B.E/B.Tech. Honors and B.E/B.Tech Minor in other specialization degree will be optional for candidates
- Candidates will be permitted to register Specialization / Minor courses from 4th / 5th semester onwards. The eligibility criteria will be the (N-1)th semester performance.

## ITEM No.12

### Comments from the Experts:

- Dr.K.Vani, University Nominee enquired about the possibility of all the students opting for NPTEL credit transfer without any CGPA limit. The Controller of Examinations clarified that all the students are permitted to undergo NPTEL courses and only students who have 7.5 and above CGPA are permitted for credit transfer. Dr.K.Vani and Dr.A.Rajeswari, University Nominee suggested to have the students who complete NPTEL courses and not satisfying eligibility criteria for credit transfer should also be considered under NPTEL credit transfer for elective courses. Hence it was concluded to discuss and take a suitable decision in the next Academic Council meeting.
- Dr.A.Rajeswari, University Nominee enquired about the students who opt for specialization, complete two courses in his/her 4<sup>th</sup> semester but somehow the student does not meet the criteria to continue the specialization courses, why these completed courses are not being considered for computing the CGPA and all these courses may be appearing in the marksheet. The Chairperson and COE replied that all the students are permitted to take specialization courses, the students eligible for undergoing specialization courses will be included in the CGPA computation and for all others a certificate of completed courses over and above the required credits will be given by Centre for Continuing Education of the institution.
- Dr.R.Vijayan, University Nominee enquired about the period of credit transfer after completing the NPTEL course. The Controller explained that the credit transfer will be done in the subsequent semester and Dr. R.Vijayan had suggested not to get confused with advancement and credit transfer. He suggested to have certain criteria for advancement of courses and not to impose any condition for NPTEL credit transfer.
- Dr. K.Vani, University Nominee questioned about the details of failed students under specialization courses. The Controller of Examinations explained that the certificate of completion of courses will be issued by Centre for Continuing

Education. The chairperson was also considering to take an equivalent NPTEL course to earn the credit and continue the remaining specialization courses.

- Dr.A.Rajeswari, University Nominee enquired about the prerequisites followed for the specialization/minor courses and any theory cum lab courses under specialization/minor courses. The Chairperson explained that the separate courses were followed with respective prerequisites for the specialization/minor courses.
- Ms. Elizabeth Puthran, Expert Nominee suggested to have integration between Entrepreneurship and innovation. She expressed concern about the number of patents filed/granted and commercialized. Nominee also commended the startup activities happening in the institution and also asked to motivate the students based startup and the need more on commercialization was stressed. The chairperson replied the patents granted are from 2013 onwards and the institution is working towards commercialization. The institution is moving towards innovation, incubation, IP and entrepreneurship together. Chairperson also informed the members about the gap year concept and live-in lab in Regulations 2020 to facilitate students who want to involve in innovation and incubation.
- Mr. Mahesh Prabhu, Expert Nominee suggested to include finance in the curriculum. He suggested to add some basic elements on taxation, indirect tax, GST etc. The Chairperson welcomed the suggestion by the nominee.
- Mr. Omkar Shankar, Expert Nominee recommended that skill upgradation is a must for everybody and welcomed the criteria of 7.5 CGPA for the students to opt for specialization courses, to ensure quality and standards. The issue of employability of the graduates was discussed.
