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






2021 - 2023 Batch M.E / M.TECH & MBA Degree Awarded

Comments from the Experts:

- 1. Dr.K.Vani, University Nominee enquired about the reason for low pass percentage of III Semester results in the programmes of Mechanical and Civil Engineering. The Chairperson and HoD of the respective programmes informed the members that the students have programming foundation papers and more analytical papers in the III semester and also the strength of lateral students is a cause for low pass percentage. Dr.K.Vani, University Nominee enquired about the bridge course for the lateral entry students and was answered suitably.
- 2. Dr.K.Vani, University Nominee insisted to have separate courses for the students who of Minors / Specialization category.
- 3. Dr.K.Vani, University Nominee enquired about the industry tie-up with institution for the specialization/minor courses and the role of the industry partner in that specialization/minor courses. Chairperson informed the members

- of the Academic Council that two or three courses will be offered and evaluated by the industry experts.
- 4. Dr.K.Vani, University Nominee informed to be clear with the specialization / minors and asked why various programmes are offering only one specialization and/or minor. Chairperson and CoE informed that to start with we offer one specialization and/or minor by each programme and later on number of verticals may be increased based on expertise and infrastructure facilities.
- 5. Dr.K.Vani, University Nominee enquired about the person available in the incubation centre. The Chairperson informed that the centre is open for outsiders and alumni requesting startup for incubation. The current students with MSME funding can also be incubated. The current student also can be provided internships with incubatees. SREC SPARK is a separate entity and is a Section 8 company.
- 6. Mr. D.Ravichandran, Nominee from Industry enquired about the employees in the incubation centre and also enquired about the software testing / Validation certification process which the chairperson explained suitably to the member.
- 7. Dr.K.Vani, University Nominee enquired about the research centres in the institution. Chairperson Academic Council informed that except Department of English all other departments are recognized research centres of Anna University. The full-time scholars will receive institution fellowhip which includes monthly stipend and also a contingency grant and other government fellowships.
