# **Comments from the Experts:**

- Dr. M. Arivanandhan, University Nominee enquired about the deviation of count in the number of publications in Scopus and Web of Science for the calendar year 2024. The Chairperson clarified the members that the scopus will include IEEE conferences and many students publish their project works in IEEE conferences and also many conferences are not listed in the Web of Science, therefore the deviation.
- Dr.M.C.Sundarraja, University Nominee suggested to increase the overall and individual h-index of the publications. He suggested to publish the articles in more reputed journals and also asked to encourage the faculty to improve the Web of Science count.
- 3. Ms. Elizabeth Puthran, Expert Nominee appreciated the patent granted and suggested to correlate the publications and patents and process the patent filing before journal publications so that the number of patents will increase.
- 4. Dr.M.S.Sundarraja, University Nominee enquired about the consultancy activities and asked to improve. He also enquired about the incentives given to the faculty with regards to consultancy. The chairperson replied with the norms of the institution and the University Nominee suggested for 70:30 will be better.
- 5. Dr. M. Arivanandhan, University Nominee enquired about the details of the Sustainable Development Goals activities of the institution. The chairperson informed the members about the initiation of energy audits and other activities planned in future.
- 6. Dr. T. Senthilkumar, University Nominee enquired about the Entrepreneurship details and the chairperson informed about the incubation centers and has 18 startups as of now in our institution with the group of 12 alumni students and faculty member combinations. Dr. B.Sharmila informed the members about the various fundings from received from apex bodies and other funding agencies.
- 7. Dr.T.Senthilkumar, University Nominee suggested to complete the project examinations within a month after completion of 4 years for the amendment in

the Revised Regulation 2020 regarding the Miniproject I and II presented by the Controller of Examinations. He also informed that after 4.5 years, if any conduction of exams will fetch the candidates second class degree. The chairperson and CoE explained that in Revised Regulations 2020, for the first class the norms of 4 years + 2 semesters will fetch them first class degree in alignment with Anna University Regulations.

- 8. Dr.T.Senthilkumar, University Nominee suggested to present the results in CGPA wise categorization in addition to the results presented in the meeting. The chairperson and controller of examinations agreed and informed the members that the results will be presented as per the suggestions from the next academic council meeting.
- 9. Dr. M. Arivanandhan, University Nominee enquired about the PG admissions and the Chairperson presented the admission statistics of PG for the academic year. The members expressed concerns over the PG admission and difficulty in faculty appointment.
